Interprets U.S. laws and regulations pertaining to the export or import of commodities, technologies, and information. Evaluates export or import control determinations. Reviews end-use applications and end-users of export or import items. Submits applications, including supporting technical documentation, for commodities, defense services, and technical assistance in order to obtain required export or import licenses or other authorizations from the appropriate regulatory agencies. Manages export and import license life cycles. Performs technology reviews and examines high-risk property. Serves as the sole interface with U.S. government export and import regulatory agencies and Lockheed Martin Corporation's International Trade Compliance Office. Ensures proper entry and clearance of imported goods through U.S. Customs and Border Protection. Investigates possible export or import violations. Provides training, consultation, and guidance to Sandia line organizations, staff, the legal department, procurement, logistics, and executive management for ongoing and future projects and programs. Employs risk management techniques to recommend Sandia export and import control policies and audits compliance with policies.

Responsible for Export Determinations of technical information, equipment and other commodities involved in international business. Works with staff and management at all levels.
