- OFAC - Spoke to Rachel Nagle (office phone, not her home phone #....) I explained, in more words, that a more "applicable" OFAC presentation would be better received, rather than the standard basic OFAC presentation. A good focus would be navigating through their regulations, and examples of where OFAC applied when EAR does not. She was extremely receptive and appreciative on the feedback. She was either taking notes as I spoke, or sending the feds to audit me. I asked her what the "popping" noise was during her presentation, she said it was her knee, and that she was very embarrassed.
- New Nuclear Initiative? If the U.S. starts building more nuclear reactors, there will be a lot of companies wanting to know how to abide by DOE/NRC regs. Different Labs will be heavily involved. Maybe a huge topic.
- Best Practices, Case Scenarios: ECCO audience seem to really appreciate these type of presentations. The difficult part is finding presenters confident enough to "reveal their laundry".

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
